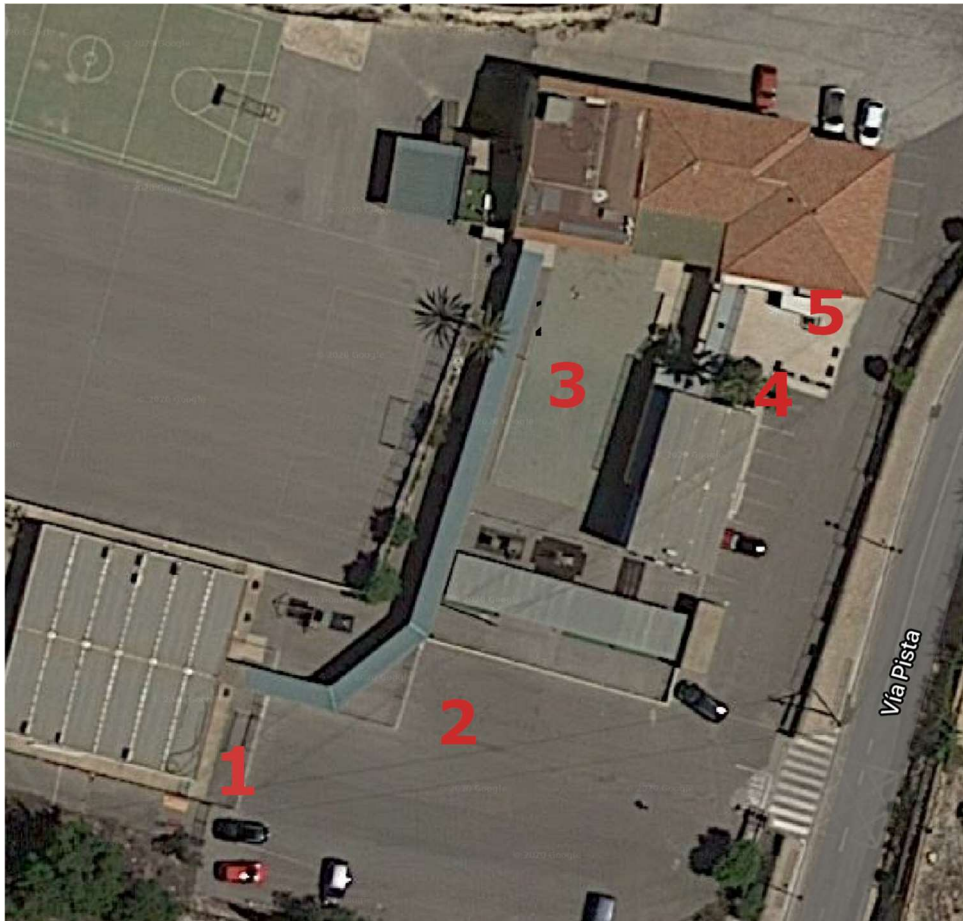


INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE RETURN TO SCHOOL

As a consequence of the current sanitary crisis produced by the Covid-19 virus, developed during the school year 2019-2020, the school has created a contingency plan. This plan was constructed on the bases of the contingency plans created by the *Conselleria de Educaci3n, Cultura y Deporte* (the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport) which developed a technical guide for the elaboration of contingency plans and the continuity of work during the Covid-19 period and the measures and the recommendations provided by the *Instituto Valenciano de Seguridad y Salud en el Trabajo (INVASSAT)* (the Valencian Institute of Security and Health in the workplace).

As a brief summary, we highlight the following important points or aspects to bear in mind:

- Entering and exiting the school will be done in an escalated way, using the five access points in the school to avoid contact between the different groups.
- In the following lines you will find the timetables and access points to the school for each of the groups:

- The parents will have to take the temperature of their children before entering the school premises. As the students arrive at school their temperature will be taken and if this exceeds 37.5 degrees, the student will not be able to access the school.
- For those students that will be taking the bus to get to the school, the bus monitor will take their temperature before entering the bus.
- Each child will be accompanied by ONE parent, which will not be able to enter the buildings, having to stay inside their vehicle waiting for their child's temperature to be taken and thus, being authorised to enter the building.
- Due to the current situation, this year the parents have the option to choose between face-to-face lessons or online lessons. Each school tutor will provide the parents with an online timetable. To aid the school to be able to coordinate the adequate measures, parents must inform the office or the tutor of which services they will require for the school year (dinning services (comedor), bus, online classes).
- All school personnel will be submitted to periodic PCR type tests.
- This year students will not be provided with medicine if they require it due to the current circumstances.
- In the case of a Covid-19 detection in a student, parents must immediately inform the school.
- At 4:15 PM the School will close and no one will be allowed to stay inside the premises after this time due to it being the time when the school is getting disinfected.
- It is prohibited to access any of the different areas of the school playground outside of the school hours.
- Each student will have to bring to school a bottle of hydroalcoholic gel and two masks. In addition, they must bring a pencil case filled with pencil colours, pencils and any material required by the teachers. All the materials will be used at an individual level to avoid the contact of object between pupils. All these materials must be marked with the students name to prevent anything from getting misplaced and lost. If anything is found not marked the school will proceed to through said object in the bin.
- The bathroom, as well as other communal areas of the school, will be disinfected after every use.
- The exits to the playground will be done with the group-class, avoiding contact with the rest of the groups/classes. To do so, we have established a timetable and specific zones for each group to play in which will be disinfected right after their use.
- In Infant education the bubble classroom system will be implemented. In secondary, students will be assigned a classroom and will not move between classes being the teacher that will do so.

- Finally, an expert teacher has been established to deal with all the aspects related to Covid-19 in the school. In addition, there has been a secure area established to isolate a student in case of a suspicion of a possible infection, which will isolate said student until the parents have arrived.

We ask for your maximum collaboration in order to maintain all the security measures and maintain a secure centre for all the students and personnel.
