


SCHOOL POLICY FOR COVID

1. Daily measures, we will be taking at school along the school year:

- Entering and exiting the school will be done in an escalated way, using the five access points in the school to avoid contact between the different groups. In the following lines you will find the timetables and access points to the school for each of the groups:



Entrance 1:	9:00 Pre-Nursery & Nursery	9:05 Year 1 Δ

- The parents will have to take the temperature of their children before entering the school premises. As the students arrive at school hydroalcoholic gel will be put on their hands and their temperature will be taken and if this exceeds 37.5 degrees, the student will not be able to access the school. For those students that will be taking the bus to get to the school, the bus monitor will take their temperature before entering the bus.
- Each child will be accompanied by ONE parent, which will not be able to enter the buildings, having to stay inside their vehicle waiting for their child's temperature to be taken and thus, being authorised to enter the building.
- To aid the school to be able to coordinate the adequate measures, parents must inform the office or the tutor of which services they will require for the school year (dinning services (comedor), bus, online classes).
- This year students will not be provided with medicine if they require it due to the current circumstances.
- In the case of a Covid-19 detection in a student or someone in the family, parents must immediately inform the school. The centre may inform health care after the notification.
- At 4:15 PM the School will close and no one will be allowed to stay inside the premises after this time due to it being the time when the school is getting disinfected. Also, it is prohibited to access any of the different areas of the school playground outside of the school hours.
- Each student will have to bring to school a bottle of hydroalcoholic gel and two masks with the name on. In addition, they must bring a pencil case filled with pencil colours, pencils and any material required by the teachers. All the materials will be used at an individual level to avoid the contact of objects between pupils. All these materials must be marked with the students name to prevent anything from getting misplaced and lost. If anything is found not marked the school will proceed to throw said object in the bin.
- The bathroom, as well as other communal areas of the school, will be disinfected after every use.
- The exits to the playground will be done with the group-class, avoiding contact with the rest of the groups/classes. To do so, we have established a timetable and specific zones for each group to play in which will be disinfected right after their use.
- In Infants, Primary and Secondary education the bubble classroom system will be implemented.

- For birthdays, children can bring individually wrapped food for their peers, this must be given to the child's teacher one day before it has to be given out. These will be put in the children's bags. They will not be allowed to eat them in class.
- Finally, an expert teacher has been established to deal with all the aspects related to Covid-19 in the school.

2. Measures school will take if there is a suspicion of case of covid at school

If along the school day a teacher sees or thinks that a student is developing symptoms of COVID-19, the teacher will:

- A. Put a mask on the student, if the student is not wearing one (under 6 years old).
- B. Take the temperature of the student. If this one is over 37.5, the student will be isolated in the Secure Area.
- C. The student will be in the Secure Area isolated until the parents arrive and pick him/her up.

3. Measures if there is a case of COVID-19 in one of the students in a class.

The parents must inform the school that their child or one of the members of their home has got the covid. This child cannot come to school until the doctors say so.

The school will call to the number given by Generalitat Valenciana and will follow the instructions they give us. The doctors will inform the school with the measures that must be taken, and we will follow all these measures.
