ACROSS THE WORLD

The school student who just turned 99

A woman who celebrates her 99th birthday today has explained how she went back to school in Kenya's Rift Valley to set a good example for her great-grandchildren.

Priscilla Sitienei, who is in her sixth year at primary school, wears the same school uniform of grey dress and green sweater as other students.

Kenya's government began subsidising the cost of primary schooling in 2003, allowing some older people who missed out on education in their younger days to revive their dreams.

A film about Priscilla's education journey - titled Gogo after the local word for grandmother - will be launched soon in New York. She said she enjoys other school activities such as physical education classes, adding: "I get to jump around, even though not as much as they can do - but I at least move my body."



Cyclone destroys dozens of schools

A cyclone that battered parts of Madagascar has put 10,000 children out of school.

In the east of the island, 69 schools were completely destroyed, 439 schools were damaged and 55 had their roofs blown off, according to Save the Children.

Cyclone Batsirai killed more than 20 people - five of them children - and displaced more than 60,000, as well as destroying crops due to be harvested.

Tatiana Dasy, Save the Children's Programme Director for Madagascar, said: "As many as 10,000 who were able to go to school last week are without education this week. After two years of being pushed out of schooling due to Covid-19, this is the last thing children need."



Back to school after a year in Vietnam

More than 17 million Vietnamese students will return to school for the first time in almost a year. The Southeast Asian country lifted many of its pandemic curbs in October – but most students had been confined to taking online classes since early last year.

Some in-person classes for secondary school students began this week and all students will be back this week. Primary and pre-primary schools will also reopen during February.

Vũ Minh Trí, an eighth grader in Hanoi, told Asia News Network: "I feel very happy and excited because it has been a long time since I went to school."



Cycling for a cause

A team of three Swiss students from the EHL Hospitality Business School, Lausanne, Switzerland (EHL), recently participated in a tour from Delhi to Chennai, to promote education and hospitality. The 15-day tour started from Taj Palace, New Delhi and covered places including Agra, Bhopal, Nagpur, Hyderabad, Hampi, Bengaluru, Madurai, and concluded at Chennai.

RECIPE ROAST

entrecot

INSTRUCTIONS

- I. Wash the bone-in pork and dry it with paper towels
- II. Then, with a sharp knife, cut the meat between the bones to get quite similar pieces
- III. How slightly tenderise the meat with a meat hammer
- IV. Now lavishly grease it with vegetable oil on both sides
- V. Heat the pan, pour some oil in and , when it boils, carefully pace the meat in the pan
- VI. Fry the pork entrecôte for approximately 30 second until the crust and it over right away. Sprinkle with coarse salt and black pepper
- VII. After 30 seconds, turn over the pork again and sprinkle with spices one more time, then cook the dish for 7 minutes on each side. Move finished steak on a paper towel to excess fat stack and fry the potato wedges in the remaining oil

INGREDIENTS

- 350 grams of bone-in pork
- Black pepper
- 7ml of vegetables oils
- Salt
- 2 potatoes

Russia's invasion of Ukraine (also Russia's war against Ukraine, "Russian Special Military Operation in Ukraine") began on the morning of February 24, 2022. The invasion was preceded by a long-term crisis in relations between Russia and Ukraine, a sharp weakening of the Russian Ruble against foreign currencies caused by a rapid decline in world oil prices, the export of which largely determines the revenue side of the Russian budget, as well as the introduction of economic sanctions against Russia in connection with the annexation of Crimea and the armed conflict in eastern Ukraine, which intensified in 2021 due to the pulling of Russian troops to the Ukrainian border.

On February 24, 2022, the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation launched a full-scale invasion, during which attacks were carried out on Ukrainian military infrastructure, aviation, air defense facilities and military airfields. For example people that live in Donbass, their lives, rights and security are most important. We don't care about their political views, we care that civilians usually die during hostilities. The UN declared 14,000 dead. There is nothing more valuable than human life - no territorial entity can be higher than this," Vasily is sure. Every day he has to tune in again, because the news situation completely changes. "It's difficult to cope with this emotionally, you have to push yourself .




In connection with the tense situation due to the special operation of Russian troops on the territory of Ukraine, the Kyiv authorities converted four metro stations into bomb shelters. Trains did not stop at Zhytomyrska, Sviatoshyn, Nivki, and Beresteiska stations. The metropolitan metro said that you can go down there in case of an air raid. Kharkiv residents were also urged to get on the subway. There they were given water, and the city authorities reported that they could accommodate about 154,000 people. Throughout the night, residents of Kyiv and Kharkov remained at metro stations, fearing air strikes. They converted train cars into sleeping places, took with them suitcases with clothes, valuables and pets.

Putin's press secretary Peskov said that the period of negotiations that will take place in Gomel on February 28, 2022 will not stop hostilities. Ukraine put forward demands to return the composition of Ukraine to Crimea, the eastern part of Ukraine, Danbass and Lungas, and to stop hostilities against Ukraine. Hopefully this will prevent War World III.




