RECIPE

MACARONS

Ingredients:

80g Egg Whites

Butter

Vanilla extract

100g Cream of tartar

Salt

100g Granulated sugar

100g Powdered sugar

100g Almond flour.

1) Sieve the icing sugar and the ground almonds together in a bowl and whisk together.

2) Whiz the dry ingredients in the food processor and then sieve again (repeat 2 times)

3) Whip the egg whites with the cream of tartar. Add vanilla and any gel food coloring in at this point.

4) Add a third of the confectioner's sugar and almond mixture and fold in gently. Add the remaining dry mixture and continue folding.

5) Transfer batter to a pastry bag fitted with a round tip. Pipe perpendicular to the surface.

6) Heat oven 300°F (150°C). Bake for 12-15 minutes. Allow then to cool for about 10 minutes on the pan then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.

7) Filling into the back of half the macaron shells. Form a sandwich and your french macarons are ready to enjoy!
